

STORYTIME WITH CAROLINE

K- 2nd GRADE

CLASS GOAL: learn valuable lessons while enjoying reading/listening to one or two moral stories per class (depending on the length of the story)

CLASS LENGTH: 45 minutes

CLASS PARTICIPANTS: 1 – 5 children (more TBD)

CLASS LOCATION: online, in a quiet place in your house. A parent/adult would need to set up the computer/laptop/tablet/smartphone. The parent/adult would need to be present at the beginning of class (5 minutes max). The parent/adult doesn't need to be present during the rest of the class. The parent/adult may need to be there at the end of the class .

CLASS DESCRIPTION: During the class we will read one or two short stories. All stories have a MORAL – the word will be introduced and explained to the students. I will read the story, then we will have a discussion based on the story. The discussion is a series of questions. Each question will be an opportunity to learn.

Example of questions: What is your favorite part of the story? Why?; Where does the story take place – setting? (What is setting?! New word?); When does the story happen – time? Was it morning, noon, afternoon, evening, night? What's the difference?; Which words in the story are tricky? etc

At the end of each story we will “discover” THE MORAL.

*If the children already know how to read they will read parts of the story after they first listened to it. I will provide copies of the story/s chosen for the class by email to the parents prior to the class so they have time to print them.

**The class starts with a short physical and vocal warm up
